ELIGIBILITY FOR ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP

Any man or woman is eligible for active membership in the Society who is at least 18 years of age and who descended from a Manakin Huguenot Founder, male or female, or is descended from a proven Huguenot who was a resident of Virginia prior to 1786; provided the applicant is personally acceptable to the Society.

JUNIOR membership is extended to Huguenot descendants under 18 years of age.

ASSOCIATE membership is extended to persons descended from a French Huguenot Immigrant to America who did not live in Virginia.

(Proof may be wills, deeds, church records, Bibles, census and pension records, tombstones, letters, family papers, books, etc. Every generation must be proved. Give authorities, published and unpublished, by title, author, edition, volume and page, covering all names, dates and places. One Photostat or certified copy of each item referred to as a proof must accompany papers. Statements based on tradition alone cannot be accepted. The references given as proof must show the connection between each generation in this line.)


