**WARD, THOMAS J., Corporal**

Resided in Franklin County where he enlisted at age 25, May 20, 1861. Mustered in as Corporal. Present or accounted for until he died in hospital at Petersburg, Virginia, March 16, 1862, of "extensive inflammation of the bowels."

**WHELESS, JOSEPH W., Sergeant**

Resided in Nash County and enlisted in Franklin County at age 19, May 20, 1861. Mustered in as Private and promoted to Sergeant on May 1, 1862. Present or accounted for until wounded in the head at Malvern Hill, Virginia, July 1, 1862. Transferred to 2nd Company K, 32nd Regiment N.C. Troops, July 4, 1862, while absent wounded.

**WILHITE, HENRY Y., Private**

Resided in Franklin County where he enlisted at age 25, May 20, 1861. Present or accounted for until transferred to 2nd Company K, 32nd Regiment N.C. Troops, July 4, 1862.

**WILSON, BENJAMIN W., Private**

Born in Franklin County where he resided as a farmer prior to enlisting in Franklin County at age 30, May 20, 1861. Present or accounted for until transferred to 2nd Company K, 32nd Regiment N.C. Troops, July 4, 1862.

**WINSTON, PATRICK H., Sergeant**

Resided in Franklin County where he enlisted at age 20, May 20, 1861. Mustered in as Private and promoted to Sergeant in September, 1861-June, 1862. Present or accounted for until wounded at Malvern Hill, Virginia, July 1, 1862. Transferred to 2nd Company K, 32nd Regiment N.C. Troops, July 4, 1862.

Troops. Being the of that regiment, it was designated 2nd Company I. The following roster covers only the period from original enlistment through July 4, 1862. All information after that date will be recorded in the roster of 2nd Company I, 32nd Regiment N.C. Troops.

The information contained in the following roster of the company was compiled principally from company muster rolls for June 4 through August, 1861. No company muster rolls were found for the period prior to June 4, 1861, or for the period after August, 1861. In addition to the company muster rolls, Roll of Honor records, receipt rolls, hospital records, prisoner of war records, and other primary records, supplemented by state pension applications, United Daughters of the Confederacy records, and postwar rosters and histories, all provided useful information.

## OFFICERS

### CAPTAINS

**IHRIE, ROSS R.**

Resided in Chatham County and enlisted at age 33. Appointed Captain on April 15, 1861. Present or accounted for until promoted to Lieutenant Colonel on June 11, 1861, and transferred to the Field and Staff of this regiment.

★ **TAYLOR, JOHN W.**

Resided in Chatham County where he enlisted at age 30, April 15, 1861. Mustered in as Sergeant and was appointed Captain to rank from June 15, 1861. Present or accounted for until he was defeated for reelection when the regiment was reorganized on May 2, 1862.

**LONDON, WILLIAM LORD**

Resided in Chatham County where he enlisted at age 24. Appointed 2nd Lieutenant on or about April 15,

through October, 1864.

## COMPANY L

★ This company was from Franklin County and enlisted at Louisburg on May 20, 1861. From Louisburg it was ordered to Franklinton and afterwards to Garysburg, where it was mustered in on June 12 and assigned to this regiment as Company L. The company served with this regiment until July 4, 1862, when it was transferred to the 32nd Regiment N.C. Troops. Because it was the second company to serve as Company K of that regiment, it was designated 2nd Company K. The following roster covers only the period from original enlistment through July 4, 1862. All information after that date will be recorded in the roster of 2nd Company K, 32nd Regiment N.C. Troops.

The information contained in the following roster of the company was compiled principally from company muster rolls for June 12-August, 1861, and May-June, 1862. No company muster rolls were found for September, 1861-April, 1862, or for the period after June, 1862. In addition to the company muster rolls, Roll of Honor records, receipt rolls, hospital records, prisoner of war records, and other primary records, supplemented by state pension applications, United Daughters of the Confederacy records, and postwar rosters and histories, all provided useful information.

**GREEN, WILLIAM F.**

Resided in Franklin County where he enlisted. Appointed Captain on May 20, 1861. Present or accounted for until promoted to Major to rank from June 11, 1861, and transferred to the Field and Staff of this regiment.

Resided in Franklin County where he enlisted at age

## LIEUTENANTS

**BALLARD, ROBERT E., 2nd Lieutenant**

Resided in Franklin County where he enlisted at age 21, May 20, 1861. Mustered in as Private and was appointed 2nd Lieutenant to rank from May 2, 1862. Present or accounted for until transferred to 2nd Company K, 32nd Regiment N.C. Troops, July 4, 1862.

**DAVIS, BARTLETT, 2nd Lieutenant**

Resided in Franklin County where he enlisted at age 24, May 20, 1861. Mustered in as Private and was appointed 2nd Lieutenant to rank from May 2, 1862. Present or accounted for until transferred to 2nd Company K, 32nd Regiment N.C. Troops, July 4, 1862.

**HARRIS, WILLIAM S., 1st Lieutenant**

Resided in Franklin County where he enlisted at age 28. Appointed 3rd Lieutenant on or about May 20, 1861, and was promoted to 1st Lieutenant on June 16, 1861. Medical records indicate he died on April 20, 1862; however, company records indicate that he was defeated for reelection when the regiment was reorganized on May 2, 1862. No further records.

**PEARCE, RICKS M., 2nd Lieutenant**

Resided in Franklin County where he enlisted at age 22, May 20, 1861. Mustered in as Private and was appointed 2nd Lieutenant to rank from July 17, 1861. Present or accounted for until he was defeated for reelection when the regiment was reorganized on May 2, 1862.

**YOUNG, WILLIAM R., 1st Lieutenant**

Resided in Franklin County where he enlisted at age 28, May 20, 1861. Mustered in as Private and appointed 1st Lieutenant to rank from May 2, 1862. Present or accounted for until transferred to 2nd Company K, 32nd Regiment N.C. Troops, July 4, 1862.

I leave in trust to JAMES A. HENLY for the use of my daughter ELIZABETH WARD during her life & then to her children - the lot on which Joseph J.
