"The Deposition of Mrs. Elizabeth Dodman aged upward of seventy years deposeth & saith That the said deponents daughter Elizabeth A....being very sick att this Deponts house butt of pfect mind & memory to the best of this deponts. Judgment, she called for William Appleyard & declared that she would give him all that she had to bring upp her child & yt.
